#### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would require secondhand media sellers to follow requirements that currently apply to a secondhand dealer regarding customer identification, transaction with minors and recordkeeping.

The department does not believe there will be any increased costs to local governments.

However, since the department is required to develop and print forms under the law so they can be provided to counties and municipalities for distribution at no cost to secondhand media sellers; there will be a fiscal effect to state government.

The department has determined increase costs of \$941 to develop, print and provide the forms that can not be absorbed by the department.
