## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

If enacted, the bill would require the person who violates any law in relation to operating a vehicle, an all-terrain vehicle, a boat, or a snowmobile to be assessed any costs associated with acquiring a blood sample and administering a blood test or analysis that were charged to, or paid by, a law enforcement agency.

The costs associated with this bill are indeterminate since it is not possible to determine the annual number of persons that may be arrested who would be affected by this bill. Additionally, there would be a minimal effect on the agency as costs associated with medical tests on persons arrested by DOA's Capitol Police amounted to less than \$1,000 during SFY07.

There would also be a small amount of additional administrative cost for billing the arrested person and maintaining the accounts receivable until the billing was paid. These costs could be absorbed by the agency.
