### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2007 AB 510 proposes to change the definition of a minority business and a minority investment firm.

The statutes currently indicate that a minority business or a minority investment firm must be at least 51% owned, controlled and actively managed by individuals who are U.S. citizens or lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence.

2007 AB 510 eliminates the language regarding permanent residents, resulting in only individuals who are United States citizens being able to meet the definition criteria for minority businesses and minority investment firms.

2007 AB 510 would result in some businesses and firms becoming ineligible for services and assistance provided to minority businesses and firms that they were previously eligible for. However, this would have no fiscal impact on the Department, nor on local units of government.
