## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB 650 will have no fiscal impact on the WERC.

AB 650 will reduce local government costs if: (1) sheriffs elect to privatize food service operations; (2) the private food service provider can provide the service at a lesser cost than can a county using county employees; and (3) the savings so generated exceed the cost of wage/fringe benefit obligations incurred by a county due to "impact" bargaining with a union representing the county employees who previously provided said food service.
