Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would allow a vehicle rental or leasing company to charge a credit card provided as a deposit for damages by the renter or lessee for any sums it has paid for costs, forfeitures, and towing and storage charges for the nonmoving violation plus assess an administrative fee of not more than \$30 against the renter or lessee.

In addition, if the rental or leased vehicle owner intends to make such charges, the vehicle owner must give written notice, to the renter or lessee, before entering into the rental or lease agreement, that charges may be made against the renter's or lessee's credit card for any forfeitures, costs, or towing and storage charges for a nonmoving traffic citation that the renter or lessee fails to pay.

The bill would require DATCP to promulgate rules to specify the form of the written notice that is to be provided to the renter or lessee by the rental or leased vehicle owner.

The Department estimates an increase in workload for a one-year period as a result of the rule development process, however it is believed this workload can be absorbed.
