Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

1. Assume all specifications under 86.196(4) Wis. Stats. apply. The bill overcomes only the eligibility criteria, used to determine whether an attraction qualifies for a sign, but does not overcome other specification criteria used to determine whether signs can be erected in a particular location. Federal sign standards prohibit erecting tourist oriented directional signs in urban areas, or within interstate highway rights of way. The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, chapter 2G, adopted by Wisconsin under s. 84.02(4)(e) prohibits the signs at the locations specified in the bill. No signs could legally be erected under the bill.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

1. None, since no signs would be erected.
