Bill Summary:

This bill provides that an ATV may be operated on a roadway or highway if it has a snow plow attached, it has a revolving yellow light that is illuminated, and if its operation on the roadway is necessary to travel to or from a site where the snow plow will be used.

Fiscal Estimate:

The Department assumes that the bill will have very minimal, if any, impact on DNR enforcement operations, and therefore assumes that this bill will have no fiscal impact to state or local government.
