**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

**PROVISIONS OF THE BILL**

Under current law, if a person who is renting or leasing a vehicle fails to pay any non-moving violations that the person received, the vehicle owner (the rental or leasing company) may avoid registration suspension/refusal under the Traffic Violation and Registration Program if the owner pays the municipality any costs and 50% of the forfeiture or towing/storage amount owed by the renter/lessee.

This bill provides that the owner must pay the municipality the full amount owed, but may charge the credit card of the person who leased/rented the vehicle, for the full amount plus an administrative fee. The owner must give the renter/lessee prior notice that the owner may charge the credit card for these charges. If the renter/lessee did not use a credit card, the owner must pay the municipality 50% as under current law.

The bill requires the Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection to promulgate rules governing the notice to the renter/lessee.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

This bill has no fiscal impact on DOT or the Transportation Fund.
