Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2007 SB 558 would make changes to the definition of plumbing indicated in s. 145.01, Stats. For example, the legislation would include systems that treat/process stormwater in the definition of plumbing and eliminate references that limit the scope of the definition to potable water (i.e. water fit for human consumption) water.

2007 SB 558 would result in clarifying and updating the definition of plumbing to more accurately reflect current plumbing technology and the current practices of the Department in the regulation of plumbing. For example, the Department currently regulates water treatment devices other than water softeners and heaters (e.g., systems that remove iron from water). Although this regulation occurs under current authority, 2007 SB 558 updates and clarifies the language to reflect new technology in water treatment devices. Also, although the Department currently regulates stormwater systems under current authority, 2007 SB 558 specifically includes this type of system.

The Department of Commerce anticipates that 2007 SB 558 would have no fiscal impact on the activities of the Department, as no additional workload or revenue would be realized from the legislation.
