EXECUTIVE ORDER #243

***Relating to a Special Session of the Legislature and
Amending Executive Order #241***

Whereas, on March 5, 2008, I, Jim Doyle, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by Executive Order # 241, required the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the State Capitol on March 13, 2008, to consider and act upon legislation relating to state finances and appropriations;

NOW, I, Jim Doyle, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Article IV, Section 11 and Article V, Section 4 of the Wisconsin Constitution, do hereby amend Executive Order # 241, to require the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, beginning at 2:00 p.m. on March 12, 2008, rather than 10:00 a.m. on March 13, 2008,

solely to consider and act upon legislation relating to: state finances and appropriations.
