2007 Wisconsin Act 33
[2007 Senate Bill 186]

Neighborhood Electric Vehicles

2007 Wisconsin Act 33 makes numerous changes relating to the regulation of neighborhood electric vehicles (NEVs), including the following:

- Eliminates municipal licensing of NEVs.
- Requires NEVs to be registered with the Department of Transportation (DOT),
- Authorizes DOT to collect a registration fee of \$23 every two years.
- Requires NEV owners to get a certificate of title from the DOT for a \$28.50 fee.
- Waives the \$9 environmental impact fee and the \$7.50 supplemental title fee for NEVs.
- Adds NEVs to the list of vehicles exempt from emission inspections.
- Only allows NEV use to be authorized on a connecting highway or across a state highway if the DOT does not object.
- Modifies the definition of NEV.
- Waives the initial registration fee for NEVs already licensed under a local ordinance.
