



## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

**2007 Wisconsin Act 62**  
[2007 Senate Bill 297]

**Nursery Dealers, Nursery Growers,  
and Christmas Tree Growers**

2007 Wisconsin Act 62 relates to the licensing of nursery dealers, nursery growers, and Christmas tree growers. It does all of the following:

- Eliminates combined licenses and requires, instead, that a person whose business includes more than one of these activities obtain a separate license for each activity.
- Clarifies that a person may operate at more than one location in the state under a single license.
- Authorizes the Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection (DATCP) to revise annual license fees by rule.
- Increases the annual license fee that a nursery dealer must pay if the nursery dealer spends more than \$3,000,000 in a year for nursery stock.
- Makes numerous other changes of a largely stylistic or “housekeeping” nature.

**Effective Date:** 2007 Wisconsin Act 62 takes effect on March 19, 2008.
