2007 Wisconsin Act 103 [2007 Assembly Bill 539]

Blood Donation by 16 Year Olds

2007 Wisconsin Act 103 amends s. 146.33 of the statutes to permit anyone who is 16 years old to donate blood in a voluntary and noncompensatory blood program if his or her parent or legal guardian consents to the donation. Prior to the enactment of Act 103, only persons age 17 or older could donate blood.

Effective Date: Act 103 takes effect on March 29, 2008.
