

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2007 Wisconsin Act 128 [2007 Senate Bill 498]

Possession of an Electric Weapon

Prior law generally prohibited a person from selling, transporting, manufacturing, possessing, or going armed with an electric weapon. The prohibition did not apply to specified individuals, including any corrections personnel in the Department of Corrections while on official duty.

Wisconsin Act 128 also exempts from the electric weapon prohibition any corrections personnel in a county while on official duty.

Effective Date: The Act takes effect on April 4, 2008.
