



## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

**2007 Wisconsin Act 142**  
[2007 Senate Bill 314]

**Remedial Legislation [Office of  
State Employment Relations]**

This legislation was suggested as remedial legislation by the Office of State Employment Relations and introduced by the Joint Legislative Council's Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., Stats.

2007 Wisconsin Act 142 clarifies that state employees at the 184-hour vacation level will be able to convert not more than 40 hours per year as credit for termination leave or as accumulated sabbatical leave (the same as employees at the 160- and 176-hour levels).
