2007 Wisconsin Act 143
[2007 Senate Bill 315]

**Remedial Legislation [Department
of Regulation and Licensing]**

This legislation was suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Regulation and Licensing (DRL) and introduced by the Joint Legislative Council's Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., Stats.

2007 Wisconsin Act 143 clarifies, consistent with current interpretation, that DRL and affiliated credentialing boards may, as a disciplinary option against a credential holder impose conditions and requirements on the credential holder *or* restrict the holder's scope of practice, *or both*.
