2007 Wisconsin Act 163
[2007 Senate Bill 234]

**57th Brigade Field Artillery Brigade
Memorial Highway**

Under *current law*, certain highway routes and bridges have been designated and marked to memorialize, commemorate, or recognize certain individuals, groups, or events.

Act 163 directs the Department of Transportation to designate and, upon receipt of sufficient contributions from interested parties, mark the entire route of STH (State Trunk Highway) 57 as the “57th Field Artillery Brigade Memorial Highway” to honor the members of the 57th Field Artillery Brigade of the Wisconsin National Guard, also known as the “Iron Brigade,” who have bravely served their country with pride, distinction, sacrifice, devotion, and honor since World War I, including deployment to Afghanistan. No state funds, other than from contributions from interested parties, may be used for the erection or maintenance of any markers on STH 57 to identify the highway as the “57th Field Artillery Brigade Memorial Highway.”

Effective Date: Act 163 takes effect on April 8, 2008.
