2007 Wisconsin Act 201
[2007 Senate Bill 48]

**Pharmacists and Pharmacy
Technicians as Volunteer Health
Care Providers**

The Volunteer Health Care Provider (VHCP) program allows certain types of health care providers to provide health care services with state agent status protection if they file a joint application with a nonprofit agency and the joint application is approved by the Department of Administration. Volunteer health care providers are physicians, dentists, dental hygienists, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, nurse-midwives, optometrists, physician assistants, and dieticians.

2007 Wisconsin Act 201 allows pharmacists and pharmacy technicians to participate in the VHCP.

Effective Date: Act 201 takes effect on April 15, 2008.
