

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2007 Wisconsin Act 206 [2007 Assembly Bill 798]

Sale of Raffle Tickets

Under *current law*, certain religious, charitable, service, fraternal, veterans, and not-for-profit organizations may conduct a raffle upon obtaining a raffle license. An organization conducting a raffle may not sell tickets for the raffle *more than 270 days* before the raffle drawing.

Act 206 provides that an organization that holds a raffle license and has been in existence for at least five years may sell raffle tickets up to one year before the raffle drawing.

Effective Date: Act 206 takes effect on April 22, 2008.
