Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 to 2007 Assembly Bill 164

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 eliminates the sunset date, created in 2005 Wisconsin Act 167, for the raw forest products, fruits, and vegetables vehicle weight limit exemption permit as it related to raw forest products. The substitute amendment also requires that the Department of Transportation and local highway authorities make frozen road declarations on the first day that conditions warrant and that these declarations become effective as of 12:01 a.m. on the second day following the declaration.

Legislative History

Representative Friske introduced Assembly Substitute Amendment 1, and the Assembly Committee on Transportation recommended adoption of the substitute amendment and passage of Assembly Bill 164, as amended, by votes of Ayes, 12; Noes, 0.
