**2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 169**

2007 Assembly Bill 169 would add “public health nurses” to the list of health professionals who may certify that a person has a disability that limits his or her ability to walk, which the person can provide to the Department of Transportation (DOT) to obtain a special disabled registration license plate or temporary disabled parking certification.

Other health professionals listed under current law are a physician licensed to practice medicine in any state, an advanced practice nurse licensed to practice nursing in any state, a physician assistant licensed or certified to practice in any state, a chiropractor licensed to practice chiropractic in any state, a Christian Science practitioner residing in this state and listed in the Christian Science journal, or in some cases, the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1 TO 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 169**

Assembly Amendment 1 would also add “podiatrists who are licensed to practice in any state” to the list of health professionals who may certify that a person has a disability that limits his or her ability to walk.

**LEGISLATIVE HISTORY**

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by Representative Nerison and adopted by the Assembly by a voice vote. Assembly Bill 169, as amended, was passed by the Assembly by a voice vote.
