



## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

**2007 Assembly Bill 201**

Assembly Bill 201 creates a sales and use tax exemption for goods and services sold to veterans organizations. Veterans organizations are Wisconsin chapters or affiliates of federally chartered veterans organizations. **Assembly Amendment 1** changes the reference from “goods and services” to “tangible personal property and taxable services.” The Department of Revenue suggested the change because the sales and use tax law does not define “goods” and instead uses the term “tangible personal property.”

### Legislative History

At an executive session on May 2, 2007, the Assembly Committee on Veterans Affairs adopted **Assembly Amendment 1** on a vote of Ayes, 8; and Noes, 0, then recommended passage of the bill, as amended, also on a vote of Ayes, 8; and Noes, 0.
