

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

This bill creates a sales and use tax exemption for the sale of personal property and taxable services sold by a home exchange service that is owned by the Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA). Under current law, residents, employees, and guests of the Wisconsin Veteran homes at King and Union Grove may purchase items in the homes' coffee shops, snack bars, and other facilities, using script (like gift certificates) issued by the DVA's home exchange service.

Assembly Amendment 1, offered by Representative Musser, deletes the reference to the home exchange service being *owned* by DVA, and instead refers to a home exchange service that receives moneys from the appropriation under s. 20.485 (1) (g) and that is operated by DVA.

<u>Legislative History</u>

At an executive session on May 2, 2007, the Assembly Committee on Veterans Affairs adopted Assembly Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0; then recommended passage of the bill, as amended, also on a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0.
