Assembly Amendment 1 requires the approval of at least seven members of the 10-member Joint Committee on State Mandates, created by the bill, for the committee to take any action. The original bill requires six votes of the Joint Committee for any committee action. The Joint Committee consists of three majority party and two minority party members from each house; at least one member of the majority party of each house appointed to the Joint Committee must also be a member of the Joint Committee on Finance.

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by the Assembly Committee on Urban and Local Affairs, which recommended adoption of the amendment by a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 1. The committee recommended passage of the proposal, as amended, by a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 1.
