2007 Assembly Bill 538

Assembly Bill 538 requires the Department of Transportation (DOT) to affix a decal of a red arrow symbol and a decal that says “Red Arrow” to National Guard special plates when the applicant identifies himself or herself as a member or former member of the 32nd Red Arrow Brigade or Division. This applies to applications for initial issuance, re-issuance, or renewal of National Guard plates. The bill also creates a new special distinguishing vehicle registration plate for members or former members of the 32nd Red Arrow Brigade or Division, with the \$15 special plate fee for this plate deposited in the veterans trust fund.

Assembly Amendment 1

Assembly Amendment 1 removes the requirement that DOT affix the red arrow decals to license plates, and instead requires these decals to be provided to the applicant to be affixed.

Assembly Amendment 2

Assembly Amendment 2 allows DOT to collect the initial costs of production of the special plates or \$28,600, whichever is less, from the \$15 special plate fee for these Red Arrow Brigade plates.

Legislative History

Assembly Amendment 1 was introduced by Representative Musser and Assembly Amendment 2 was introduced by Representative Petrowski. The Assembly Committee on Transportation recommended adoption of these two amendments and passage of Assembly Bill 538, as amended, by votes of Ayes, 12; Noes, 0.
