The Bill

Assembly Bill 857 modifies and expands the duties of a real property lister appointed by a county board. Among other duties, the bill requires that a lister create and maintain databases of real property ownership, assessment, and taxation information and provide for the electronic transfer and publication of such databases to taxation district assessors; city, village, and town clerks and treasurers; county offices; and the Department of Revenue (DOR).

Assembly Amendment 1

Assembly Amendment 1 specifies that the lister must create and maintain the required databases in the manner prescribed by DOR.

Assembly Amendment 1 also provides that the provisions of the bill first apply to property tax assessments as of January 1, 2009.

Legislative History

On March 6, 2008, the Assembly Committee Housing offered Assembly Amendment 1 and recommended adoption of the amendment on a vote of Ayes, 4; Noes, 0. The committee recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a votes of Ayes, 4; Noes, 0.
