Current law sets various fees that a notary public may receive for the provision of specified services. [See s. 137.01 (9), Stats.]

Senate Bill 54 repeals the statutory fees, leaving the fee determination to the notary public and the customer.

Senate Amendment 1 provides that a notary public may only charge a fee for notarizing a document and that the fee may not exceed \$10 for each document that he or she notarizes.

Legislative History

On July 11, 2007, the Senate Committee on Judiciary and Corrections introduced and adopted Senate Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 4; Noes, 1. The committee recommended Senate Bill 54 for passage, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 3; Noes, 2.
