



2007 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 6

January 12, 2007 – Introduced by Representative PARISI, cosponsored by Senator MILLER. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Doris J. Hanson.

2 Whereas, Doris J. Hanson was born on October 24, 1925, in Madison,
3 Wisconsin, and died on November 8, 2006; and

4 Whereas, Doris J. Hanson graduated from Madison East High School and
5 attended UW-Madison; and

6 Whereas, Doris J. Hanson was appointed secretary of the Wisconsin
7 Department of Administration by Governor Anthony Earl and served from 1983
8 until 1987; and

9 Whereas, Doris J. Hanson was elected a trustee of the Village of McFarland
10 from 1988 to 1991 and village president from 1991 to 1995; and

11 Whereas, Doris J. Hanson was first elected to the Wisconsin Assembly in 1992,
12 serving in the 1993 through 1997 sessions; and

13 Whereas, after her retirement from the legislature, Doris J. Hanson was
14 appointed executive director of Technology for Educational Achievement (TEACH)

1 Wisconsin by Governor Tommy G. Thompson and reappointed by Governor Scott
2 McCallum, serving as its executive director from 1998 to 2002; and

3 Whereas, Doris also served as commission member of the Commission for the
4 Study of Administrative Value and Efficiency, the Governor’s Blue Ribbon
5 Commission on 21st Century Jobs, the Governor’s Blue Ribbon Task Force on
6 Telecommunications, the Governor’s Glass Ceiling Commission, and the Human
7 Resources Reform Commission; and

8 Whereas, in September 2006, Doris J. Hanson was appointed to the Board of
9 Administrative Oversight by Chief Justice Shirley Abrahamson; now, therefore be
10 it

11 ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That:*** the members of the
12 Wisconsin legislature commend the devoted public service that Doris J. Hanson
13 contributed to this state and her community, express their sorrow at her death, and
14 extend their condolences to her family and friends; and, be it further

15 ***Resolved, That*** the assembly chief clerk shall provide a copy of this joint
16 resolution to Doris J. Hanson’s brother, Frank Hanson; her nephew, Jeffrey Hanson
17 of Reston, Virginia; and her niece, Gloria DeVall of Jacksonville, Florida.
