Beth,

This will confirm our phone conversation of today regarding my appearance before the Senator's committee on Tuesday, January 29th. I want to be sure that the committee members are aware of the following. This office has served as local counsel for Covington and Burling in Washington, D.C. Covington has brought suit against numerous insurance carriers who were on the risk for National Cash Register Company at the time when it operated the Appleton mill which was later sold to Appleton Papers. Prior to that, when the potentially responsible party letter was received by Fort Howard before it became James River and later became Georgia-Pacific, we were also advising Fort Howard on its rights with regard to insurance coverage for the PCB problem in the Fox River.

I have disclosed all this to the Governor's office and they have concluded that this prior activity on our part does not constitute a conflict of any kind. My understanding is that the purpose of the Authority is to receive proposals from private land owners as to how they can modify their land or operational practices to prevent further pollution of the river. However, I believe this deals with phosphate farm runoff and other such problems that have absolutely to do with PCBs in the Fox River. My prior work for Fort Howard and National Cash Register rather than creating a conflict, I believe is a positive in the sense that in the course of those assignments I have read thousands of documents concerning the PCB problem, the various suggested methods of cleanup, etc. I am also familiar with computer modeling as to how various pollutants behave once they get into the water during heavy rainstorms and other events that disturb their location. I am also familiar with the effect on wildlife of certain pollutants. However, if Senator Miller or there committee members to see this as a conflict, I would like to be advised of that in advance of the hearing.

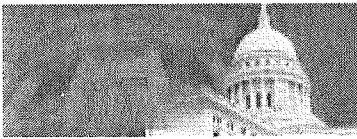

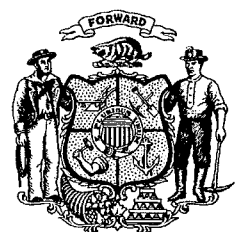


