Objectives

I would like to request the re-appointment to the Kickapoo Valley Reserve (Reserve) Board in the capacity of the Environmental Representative which I now hold. In doing so, I bring to the Reserve Board, environmental and cultural expertise by way of adding a diverse knowledge, sensitivity and practicality which the Reserve Board has come to be known for amongst its communities. Doing so will serve to benefit the Reserve in its endeavors to preserve, enhance and perpetuate the legacy of such a valuable Wisconsin resource.

More specifically, I desire to represent and contribute to the Reserve Boards environmental aspects in a way that is positive and forthcoming - to preserve and enhance what the State of Wisconsin and its people, holds dear.

Skill Section

To date, I am actively involved with the daily activities of the Kickapoo Valley Reserve and its management process which includes direct involvement by way of the Reserve side committee meetings. At present, I also sit on the Land Management and the Finance and Tourism side committees.

I currently work for the Ho-Chunk Nation (Nation) Heritage Preservation Department / Division of Cultural Resources as the Tribal Historic Preservation Officer (THPO). Responsibilities include the practice of cultural and environmental management on Nation trust properties as well as Nation owned fee-simple lands. Requirements insistent with this position include extensive pre-historic, historic and modern day knowledge on environmental aspects within our surrounding areas. This serves as a benefit for handling the environmental issues that are relative to the Reserve's needs as well.

I currently sit on the USDA/FSA Committee in Sauk County as an Advisor (2000 – present) which allows me the opportunity to understand the agricultural practices that influence our region.

Through the years I have also taken advantage of a variety of formal training that enhances my ability to deal with environmental issues as well as having at my disposal a tribal Natural Resources Division dedicated to working with environmental issues (HCN DNR).

I presently give formal lectures regarding the history of the Ho-Chunk in our aboriginal lands; as well as speak to informal groups on a regular basis regarding environmental issues, as well as traditional plants and medicines associated with the Reserve areas as well. Oral dissertation plays a major role with the history and heritage of the Nation and its ties to the Wisconsin, Illinois, Minnesota, Iowa, South Dakota and

Nebraska areas. Having knowledge of such history is a key attribute in protecting sites pertinent to a people whose history is directly involved and attached to its environmental aspects.



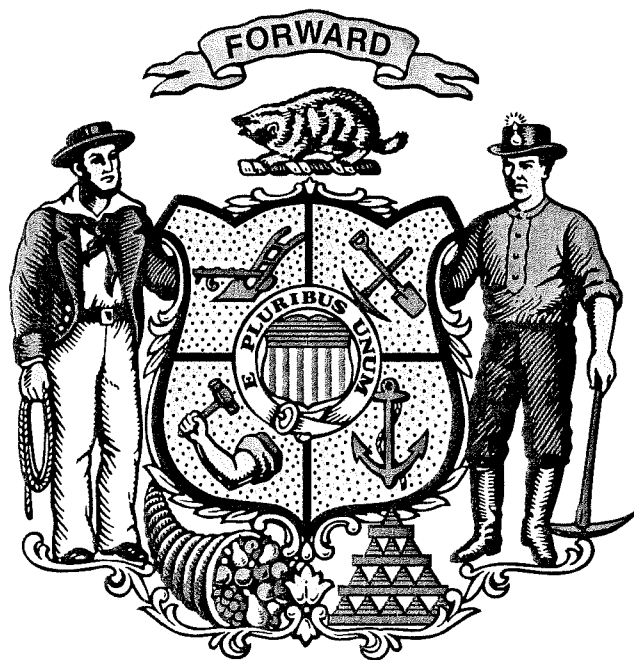

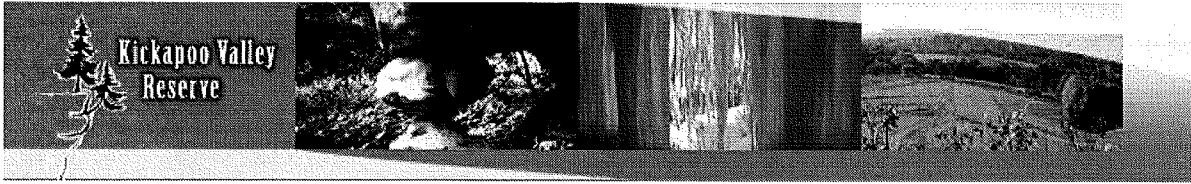

Management Board

The Kickapoo Reserve Management Board (Board) is an eleven-member citizen board that is attached to the Wisconsin Department of Tourism under **section 15.03**, Wisconsin Statutes. The Board is created under **section 15.445(2)**, Wisconsin Statutes, and consists of the following members appointed by the governor to serve for staggered three-year terms:

1. Four members who are residents of the area composed of the villages of La Farge and Ontario, the towns of Stark and Whitestown, and the school districts encompassing the villages of La Farge and Ontario.
2. Two members who are residents of that portion of the Kickapoo River watershed, as determined by the Department of Natural Resources, that lies outside of the area specified in # 1.
3. Three members who are not residents of the watershed specified in #2, one of whom shall be an advocate for the environment, one of whom shall have a demonstrated interest in education, and one of whom shall represent recreation and tourism interests.
4. One member who is a resident of the area composed of the areas specified in #1 and #2, to be recommended by the Ho-Chunk Nation.
5. One member who has an interest and knowledge of the cultural resources within the Kickapoo River watershed, to be recommended by the Ho-Chunk Nation.

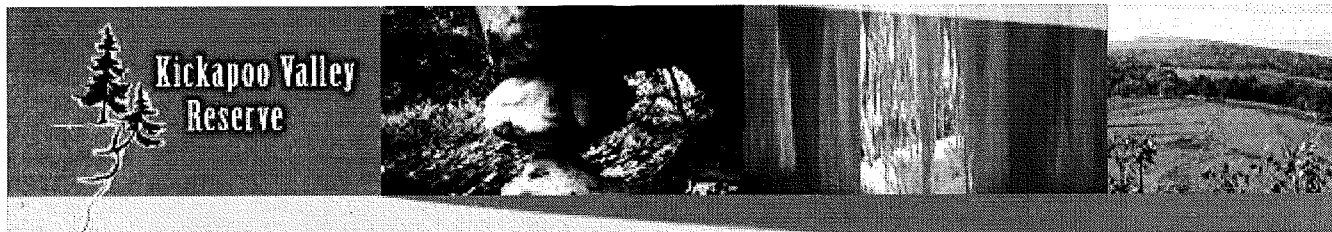
The Board manages the Reserve on behalf of the Ho-Chunk Nation and the State of Wisconsin. The Board duties and powers are outlined in **section 41.40**, Wisconsin Statutes.

The rules of the Kickapoo Valley Reserve are defined in **chapter KB 1**, Wisconsin Administrative Code.

The Kickapoo Valley Reserve Board meets on the third Thursday of each month at the Visitor Center at 7pm.
