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

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau comma stays

> Under current law, the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) regulates retail food establishments, such as grocery stores, and the department of health and family services (DHFS), which is renamed the Department of Health Services on July 1, 2008, regulates restaurants.

This bill requires DATCP and DHFS to prepare a plan to consolidate their food safety programs into one food safety program and to submit the plan to the legislature.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.
