Hi Christopher, could we get an amendment to AB along the lines of the following?

1. Consumer goods, as defined in s. 409.102 (1) (fm). A consumer good does not include any product to the extent that unique identification via radio frequency is an essential part of the consumer's use, including, but not limited to, commercial mobile radio service as described in 47 U.S.C. section 332, electronic toll collection systems as defined in RSA 236:31, I(c), keys, motor vehicle keyless access devices, motor vehicle tire pressure monitors, and garage door openers.
