Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a maximum finance charge of 2% per month for certain motor vehicle title and payday loans and requires the Department to enforce the provisions of the bill. Lenders covered by the provisions of this bill are currently licensed and regulated as licensed lenders.

Currently, these lenders charge over 500% APR for these types of loans. Given the parameters of this bill, it is likely that these lenders would choose not to be licensed by the state, and either discontinue operations or operate without a license. Assuming 500 lenders would no longer be licensed, with an annual renewal rate of \$500, and an estimated additional \$40,000 associated with fees not received from potential new licensees, annual license revenue would be reduced by \$290,000.

Costs associated with these lenders would not measurably be affected as the Department is given responsibility for enforcement of the provisions of this bill and would need to maintain a reasonable level of complaint resolution and enforcement activity.
