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

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Commerce awards grants to agencies and shelter facilities that provide temporary shelter for homeless individuals and families. Grant proceeds may be used to supplement the operating budgets of agencies and shelter facilities that have, or anticipate, a need for additional funding because of the renovation or expansion of an existing shelter facility, the development of an existing building into a shelter facility, the expansion of shelter services for homeless persons, or an inability to obtain adequate funding for an existing level of services. Current law requires the department to allocate in each year, at least \$400,000 to eligible applicants located in Milwaukee County; at least \$66,500 to eligible applicants located in Dane County; and at least \$100,000 to eligible applicants not in Milwaukee County or Dane County. Grants are funded by general purpose revenue (GPR) and by the proceeds of landlord sales of tenants' abandoned personal property. Currently, \$1,506,000 in GPR is appropriated in each of fiscal years 2007-08 and 2008-09 for grants under both this program and a separate program that funds transitional housing.

This bill increases the GPR appropriation in both fiscal years by \$50,000. Under the bill, the department must allocate \$116,500 in each year to eligible recipients in Dane County. Of that amount, the bill requires the department to

- ✓ The analysis uses "eligible applicants" without defining the term. Would you like to define the term or use something like "agency and shelter facility"? Also, I note the use of "eligible recipients" at the end of par. 2, line 2. *How about eligible recipients? thru-out.*
- ✓ Par. 1, last full line: Should these years be left as they were? *Yes*
- ✓ Par. 2, line 1: "both fiscal years" is now problematic. As you point out in the d-note, there are some issues with fulfilling the requester's intent right now. Maybe: "This bill increases the GPR appropriation annually by \$50,000." But that's not quite it either...do we just catch it when it comes around again? *I think so.*
- ✓ Par. 2., line 2: Do you want to add the bold and italic words: "must allocate *at least* \$116,500"? *Words, but maybe not bold + italic*

- ✓ Is "vicinity of the state capitol building" too vague? *Maybe, but requester seems to be ok with letting Commerce sort it out.*
