## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill increases the appropriation that funds temporary shelter grants in both fiscal years of the 2009-11 biennium by \$50,000 per year. Currently, Commerce funds grants to agencies and shelter facilities that provide temporary shelter for homeless individuals and families. The allocation for Dane County is at least \$66,500. Under the bill, the department must allocate at least \$116,500 in each year to eligible recipients in Dane County. Of that amount, the bill requires the department to allocate not less than \$50,000 in each year to eligible applicants that provide temporary shelter for homeless individuals and families in the vicinity of the state capitol.

This bill provides additional funding to the Department. However, it is likely that the additional workload will be minimal because the bill affects the allocation of funds within Dane County and does not impose additional workload requirements. Thus, it is anticipated that any workload increase can be absorbed within existing staff resources.
