



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 116**

January 27, 2010 – Offered by Representative BLACK.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 11: delete lines 11 to 16.

3 **2.** Page 4, line 23: after that line insert:

4 “**SECTION 9m.** 103.10 (7) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 103.10 (7) (title) CERTIFICATION; DOCUMENTATION.

6 **SECTION 9n.** 103.10 (7) (am) of the statutes is created to read:

7 103.10 (7) (am) When an employee returns from school conference and
8 activities leave, the employer may require the employee to provide, in a reasonable
9 and practicable manner, documentation from his or her child’s school stating no more
10 than that the employee was attending a school conference or classroom activity, or
11 was observing and monitoring services and programming, as described in sub. (4m),
12 during the period of that leave.

13 **SECTION 9p.** 103.10 (7) (b) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

1 103.10 (7) (b) (intro.) No employer may require certification under par. (a)

2 stating more than the following:”.
