Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits a school district from commencing fall classes in any year until September 1.

This bill eliminates this prohibition beginning in the 2011–12 school year. For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
