Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the secretary of natural resources is nominated by the governor, and with the advice and consent of the senate appointed, to serve at the pleasure of the governor. Under this substitute amendment, the senate my not consider a nominee for secretary of natural resources unless the Natural Resources Board has approved the nomination.

Under current law, the Natural Resources Board consists of seven members nominated by the governor, and with the advice and consent of the senate appointed, for six-year terms. As with members of other state boards, a member of the Natural Resources Board may continue to serve after the expiration of his or her term until a successor is nominated and the senate consents to the nomination. This substitute amendment provides that the position of a member of the Natural Resources Board nominated after January 2, 2011, becomes vacant upon the expiration of the member's term. This change triggers the application of a current provision under which the governor may provisionally fill a vacancy, without the consent of the

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senate. The provisional appointment remains in effect until the senate acts on the appointment.
