Sen. Darling is requesting a simple amendment to SSA 2 (LRBs0364/1) to AB 214. The amendment would insert language on p. 7, line 10, providing that a posttermination contact agreement entered into by a parent, as defined for purposes of WICWA, may not include the provision in s. 48.429 (3) (a).

ICWA AMENDMENT TO AB-214

When an Indian family gives up their child for adoption, they have 2 years to withdraw consent to the adoption agreement if they show there was fraud or duress.

The proposed Posttermination Contact Agreement (PCA) contains a provision that says an adoption cannot be terminated using the reason that the PCA was violated.

If the violation of the PCA was related to <u>fraud</u> or <u>duress</u> this provision will take away the right of an Indian family to terminate an adoption that already exists under ICWA.

Therefore the provision needs to be amended to make sure it does not apply to Indian adoptions.

This is done by inserting on page 7, at the end of line 10 the following:

This section does not apply to a birth parent who meets the definition of 'parent' for purposes of application of section 48.028.
