After extensive discussion with members of the Assembly Children and Families Committee, the decision has been made to seek an amendment to the this bill (AB 238 or LRB-1081/1) to limit the income of a spouse who could be married by someone in the program (medically needy MA recipient who is either blind or totally and permanently disabled). That income limit would be \$500,000 in annual income.

Is this something we could have drafted as a simple amendment to the bill?
