



## 2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 276

May 19, 2009 – Introduced by Representatives SMITH, RHOADES, HIXSON, SOLETSKI, GARTHWAITE, TURNER, MOLEPSKE JR., SHILLING, GRIGSBY, MONTGOMERY, DANOU, KESTELL, TOWNSEND, A. OTT, BROOKS, LOTHIAN and MURTHA, cosponsored by Senators LASSA, HARSDFORF, VINEHOUT, HANSEN, KREITLOW, HOLPERIN and SCHULTZ. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

1     **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 15.91; and *to create* 15.91 (2) of the statutes;  
2           **relating to:** composition of the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin  
3           System.

### ***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Currently, 14 citizen members serve on the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System. This bill divides the state into seven geographical areas, called districts, and requires that at least one citizen member of the Board of Regents reside in each district. The requirement takes effect on January 1, 2015.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

4           **SECTION 1.** 15.91 of the statutes is renumbered 15.91 (1) and amended to read:  
5           15.91 (1) There is created a board of regents of the University of Wisconsin  
6           System consisting of the state superintendent of public instruction; the president,  
7           or by his or her designation another member, of the technical college system board  
8           and; 14 citizen members appointed for staggered 7-year terms; and 2 students

1 enrolled at least half-time and in good academic standing at institutions within the  
2 University of Wisconsin System who are residents of this state, for 2-year terms.

3 **(3)** The student members may be selected from recommendations made by  
4 elected representatives of student governments at institutions within the University  
5 of Wisconsin System. The governor shall appoint one student member who is at least  
6 18 years old and one undergraduate student member who is at least 24 years old and  
7 represents the views of nontraditional students, such as those who are employed or  
8 are parents. The governor may not appoint a student member from the same  
9 institution in any 2 consecutive terms; the 2 student members who are appointed  
10 may not be from the same institution; and a student from the University of  
11 Wisconsin–Madison and a student from the University of Wisconsin–Milwaukee  
12 may not serve on the Board of Regents at the same time. If a student member loses  
13 the status upon which the appointment was based, he or she shall cease to be a  
14 member of the board of regents.

15 **SECTION 2.** 15.91 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

16 15.91 (2) At least one of the citizen members shall reside in each of the following  
17 districts:

18 (a) District number one, consisting of Ashland, Barron, Bayfield, Burnett,  
19 Chippewa, Douglas, Dunn, Eau Claire, Iron, Lincoln, Oneida, Pierce, Polk, Price,  
20 Rust, Sawyer, St. Croix, Taylor, Vilas, and Washburn counties.

21 (b) District number 2, consisting of Brown, Calumet, Door, Florence, Forest,  
22 Kewaunee, Langlade, Manitowoc, Marathon, Marinette, Menominee, Oconto,  
23 Outagamie, Portage, Shawano, and Waupaca counties.

1 (c) District number 3, consisting of Buffalo, Clark, Crawford, Grant, Iowa,  
2 Jackson, Juneau, La Crosse, Lafayette, Monroe, Pepin, Richland, Trempealeau,  
3 Vernon, and Wood counties.

4 (d) District number 4, consisting of Adams, Columbia, Dane, Green Lake,  
5 Marquette, Sauk, and Waushara counties.

6 (e) District number 5, consisting of Dodge, Fond du Lac, Sheboygan, and  
7 Winnebago counties.

8 (f) District number 6, consisting of Green, Jefferson, Kenosha, Racine, Rock,  
9 and Walworth counties.

10 (g) District number 7, consisting of Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Washington, and  
11 Waukesha counties.

12 **SECTION 3. Effective date.**

13 (1) This act takes effect on January 1, 2015.
