AN ACT ...; relating to: contributions by state contractors, grantees or loan recipients to certain elective state officials?

### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits any person (legal entity) other than an individual that enters into a contract with, obtains a grant from, or receives a loan from any state agency from making a political contribution to an incumbent governor or lieutenant governor, or an incumbent state senator or representative to the assembly, during the term of office of the incumbent who is serving at the time that the contract is entered into, the grant is made, or the proceeds of the loan are received. The prohibition also applies to the personal campaign and authorized support committees of such an incumbent.

No similar provision exists currently except that a corporation or cooperative is prohibited from making political contributions in most cases.

Violators of the prohibition created by the bill are subject to a forfeiture (civil penalty) of treble the amount or value of any unlawful contribution. Intentional violators are guilty of a misdemeanor and may be fined not more than \$1,000 or imprisoned for not more than six months or both.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 11.386 of the statutes is created to read:

11.386 Contributions by state contractors, grantees, and loan recipients. (1) In this section:

- (a) "Agency" has the meaning given under s. 16.70 (1e).
- (b) "Authorized support committee" means a support committee under s. 11.18 that is authorized by a candidate to act on his or her behalf under s. 11.05 (3) (p).
- (2) No person other than an individual that enters into a contract with, obtains a grant from, or receives a loan from, any agency may make a contribution to the governor or lieutenant governor or a state senator or representative to the assembly, or to the personal campaign or authorized support committee of such an officer during the term of office of the incumbent who is serving at the time that contract is entered into, the grant is made, or the proceeds of the loan are received.
