Aaron,

The answer to your question is basically "yes." After the bill is enacted, DOT cannot put up any new signs and has to let the existing signs (renewed annually) expire. DOT will then have about 2 years to take down the existing signs (at its convenience). There will be some expense to DOT, but I think the bill minimizes that expense (so yes, I'd say there is no "undue cost"). And you're correct that your constituent become eligible for the TOD sign upon publication.

If this is what you want, let me know and I will convert it to a /1.
