Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Currently, felons are not allowed to vote until such time as the felon is no longer on supervision by the Department or until the felon is pardoned. This bill allows felons to vote unless the felon is physically in jail or prison [original conviction or revocation]. This bill requires the Department to notify all non-incarcerated felons currently being supervised by the Department that the felon's voting rights have been restored and requires the Department to train its staff about the change.

The one-time notification for current non-incarcerated felons results in a cost of approximately \$20,550 for postage and mailing services [41,429 non-incarcerated felons as of June 30, 2009]. Training costs will be negligible--pre-service and agent basic training, continuing education and written policies will inform staff about the changes.
