Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Bill Summary:

This bill makes it a Class 1 Felony penalty – for which the penalty is a fine not to exceed \$10,000 or imprisonment not to exceed three years and six months, or both – for a person who intentionally or recklessly kills or harms a wild mammal or bird by pursuing or harassing the mammal or bird with a motorboat or motor vehicle or by using the boat or vehicle to kill or harm the mammal or bird. If the person committing the act does so with a recreational vehicle (such as a snowmobile, all–terrain vehicle, motorboat, or personal watercraft), the bill gives the court the ability to order the Department to suspend for a period of time, or permanently revoke, any registration certificate for any recreational vehicle that was issued to the convicted person or any trail pass or trail use sticker and may also order the Department to not issue any such registration certificates or trail use stickers to the person in the future. Under the bill, the court may also suspend or permanently revoke the convicted person's privilege to operate a recreational vehicle. Also, under the bill, a person who kills or harms any wild mammal or bird while operating a motorboat or a motor vehicle off of a roadway shall, without delay and by the quickest means available, give notice of the incident to a conservation warden or local law enforcement officer.

State Fiscal Estimate:

There will be significant programming changes to the Automated License Issuance System (ALIS) and/or the Vehicle Registration system to revise the trail pass issuance in order to revoke a specific customer and pass, and to issue and/or revoke a license; the current system does not retain unique customer information. Assuming \$95 per hour for programming and 100 hours, the Department estimates a one-time cost of \$9,500 to update systems

There will be some associated workload costs related to handling, receiving, documenting and investigating calls related to reporting of wild animals killed or harmed during off road operation of motorboat or recreational vehicle. Since it is not possible to determine how many of these incidents will occur, it is not possible to estimate the associated workload costs of the bill. These costs are indeterminate.

Local Fiscal Estimate:

It is assumed the local law enforcement officers will also have some increased workload based on the provisions of this bill. These costs are also indeterminate.
