## 2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 386

August 18, 2009 – Introduced by Representatives Schneider, Berceau, Bies, A. Ott, Steinbrink and Zepnick, cosponsored by Senators Lassa, Taylor and Olsen. Referred to Committee on Personal Privacy.

1 AN ACT *to create* 134.725 of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting the compilation of commercial mobile service numbers.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits a person from compiling commercial mobile service telephone numbers (cellular telephone numbers) for the purpose of including the telephone numbers in a directory of commercial mobile service telephone numbers that is offered for sale or lease to another.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 134.725 of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 **134.725** COMPILATION OF COMMERCIAL MOBILE SERVICE NUMBERS. **(1)** In this section, "commercial mobile service" has the meaning given in s. 196.01 (2i).
