



2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 386

August 18, 2009 – Introduced by Representatives SCHNEIDER, BERCEAU, BIES, A. OTT, STEINBRINK and ZEPNICK, cosponsored by Senators LASSA, TAYLOR and OLSEN. Referred to Committee on Personal Privacy.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 134.725 of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting the
2 compilation of commercial mobile service numbers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits a person from compiling commercial mobile service telephone numbers (cellular telephone numbers) for the purpose of including the telephone numbers in a directory of commercial mobile service telephone numbers that is offered for sale or lease to another.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 134.725 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **134.725** COMPILATION OF COMMERCIAL MOBILE SERVICE NUMBERS. **(1)** In this
5 section, “commercial mobile service” has the meaning given in s. 196.01 (2i).
6 **(2)** No person may compile the commercial mobile service telephone numbers
7 of individuals for the purpose of including the telephone numbers in a directory of
