Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2009 SB 267 makes changes to the definition of plumbing, as indicated by Chapter 145 of the Wisconsin Statutes. Plumbing is currently defined to include a drain or waste piping system that emanates from the outside foundation walls of a building to a main or other sewage system terminal. SB 267 would change that definition by removing the requirement that the system emanate from an outside foundation wall (e.g., a stormwater management system installed at a school athletic field). A plumbing system is also currently defined to include a system that prevents the back-flow of contaminated water into a supply of potable water (cross connection control). SB 267 removes potable from that definition, reflecting that there are current applications of cross-connection control technology that involve preventing back-flow of contaminated water into a non-potable water supply (e.g., reclaimed water systems).

The changes indicated in SB 267 would reflect the current practice and technology of the plumbing industry, and of the Department in the regulation of plumbing. Activities conducted by the Department in the administration of the law and rules related to plumbing are: licensing of individuals engaged in plumbing, plan review of plumbing installations in the construction of commercial buildings, field consultation and continuing education training.

SB 267 would have no financial impact on the Department.
