Jeff Kostelic:

Current law s. 254.71 (2) provides that a person must pass a written examination or achieve "comparable compliance" to obtain a certificate of food protection practices. This bill requires that a person pass a written examination to renew a certificate. Thus, under the bill, a person may obtain a certificate without passing an examination, but must pass the examination for renewal. Is this ok? Do you want to repeal the language allowing "comparable compliance" for initially obtaining a certificate?

The bill includes a delayed effective date.
