

655.45 (1m) For the quarter beginning on July 1, 1995, and for each quarter thereafter, the director of state courts shall file reports complying with sub. (2) with the dietitians dietetic nutrition care services affiliated credentialing board regarding health care providers certified licensed by the dietitians dietetic nutrition care services affiliated credentialing board.

SECTION 67. Nonstatutory provisions.

- (1) Exemptions from certain licensure requirements.
- (a) Individuals certified by the dietitians affiliated credentialing board as a dietitian on the effective date of this act. Notwithstanding section 448.78 (3) to (5) of the statutes, as affected by this act, no later than the first day of the 7th month beginning after the effective date of this paragraph, the dietetic nutrition care services affiliated credentialing board shall grant a license under section 448.78 of the statutes, as affected by this act, to an individual who, on the the effective date of this act, held a valid certificate as a dietitian granted by the dietitians affiliated credentialing board.
- (b) Individuals registered as a registered dietitian with the American Dietetic Association on the effective date of this act. Notwithstanding section 448.78 (3) to (5) of the statutes, as affected by this act, the dietetic nutrition care services affiliated credentialing board shall grant a license under section 448.78 of the statutes, as affected by this act, to an individual who no later than the first day of the 13th month beginning after the effective date of this paragraph provides sufficient evidence to the dietetic nutrition care services affiliated credentialing board that the individual was registered as a registered dietitian with the commission on dietetic registration of the American Dietetic Association on the effective date of this act.

SECTION 68. Effective date.
